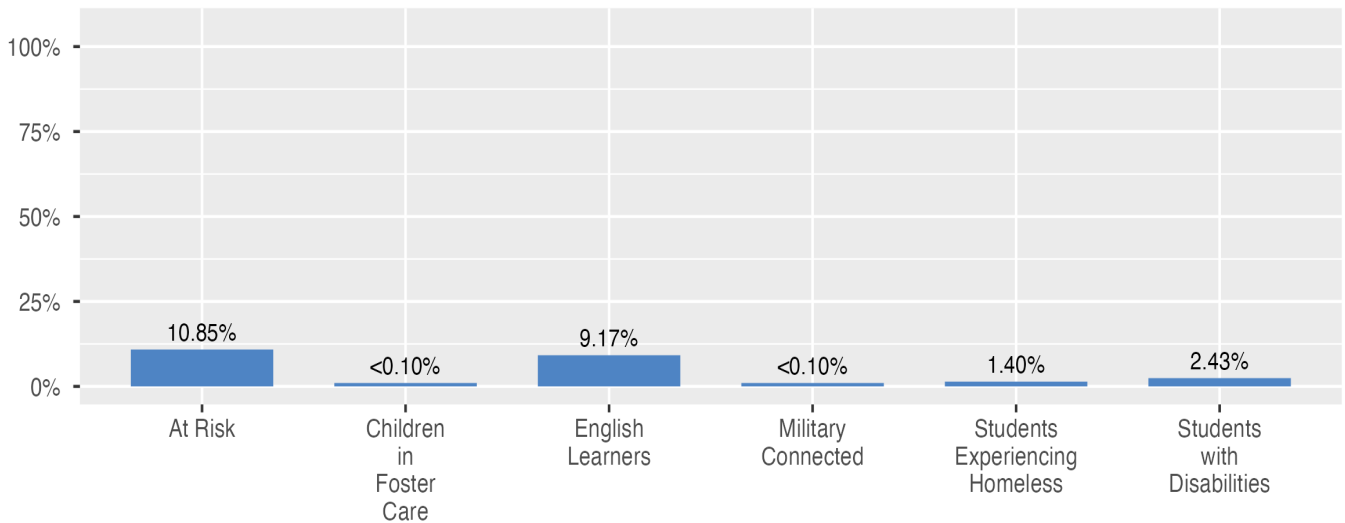
School Enrollment

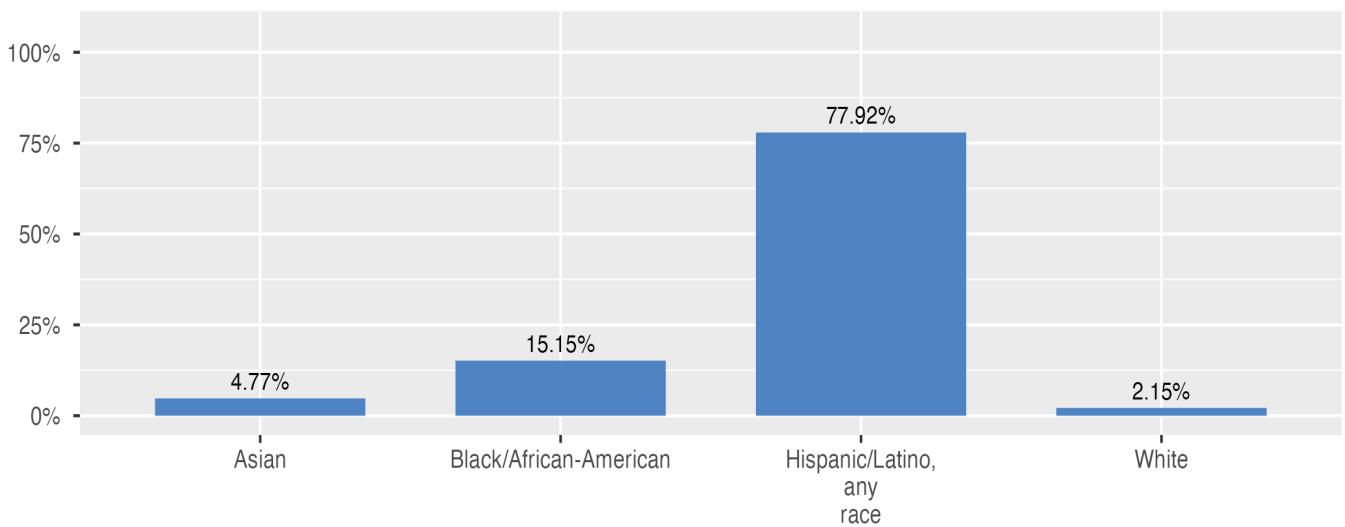

Enrollment by Student Group



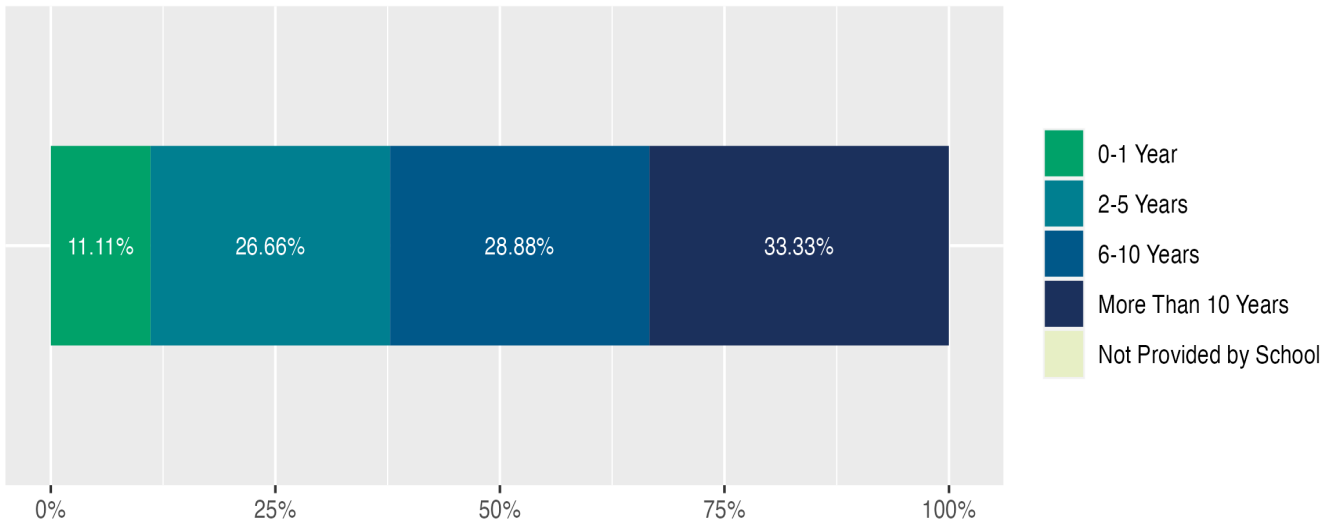
Enrollment by Race/Ethnicity



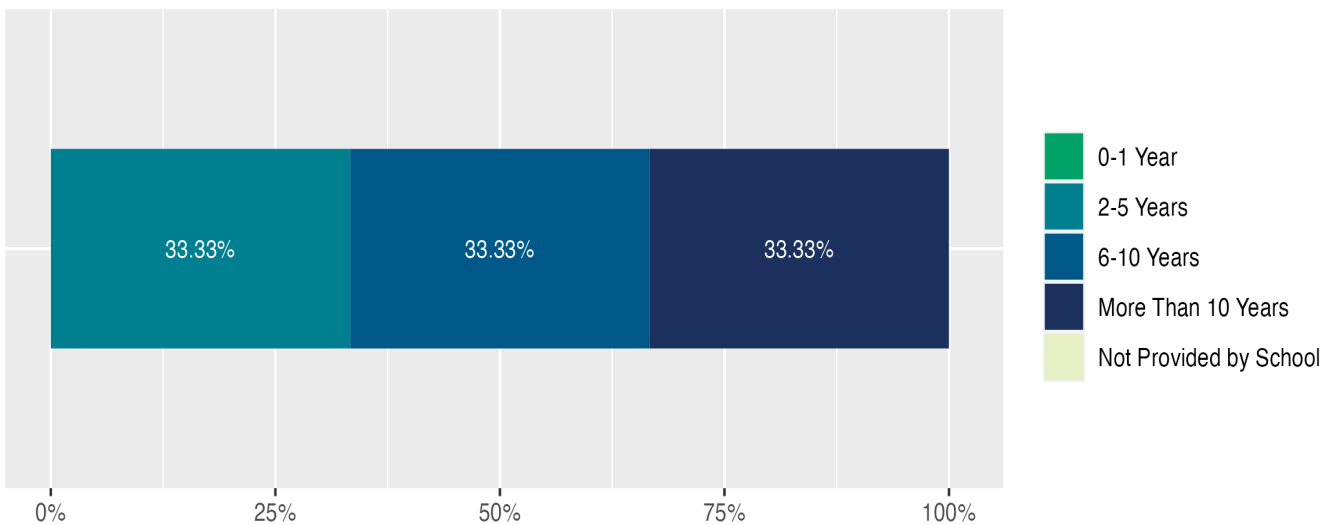

School Leader - Years of Experience

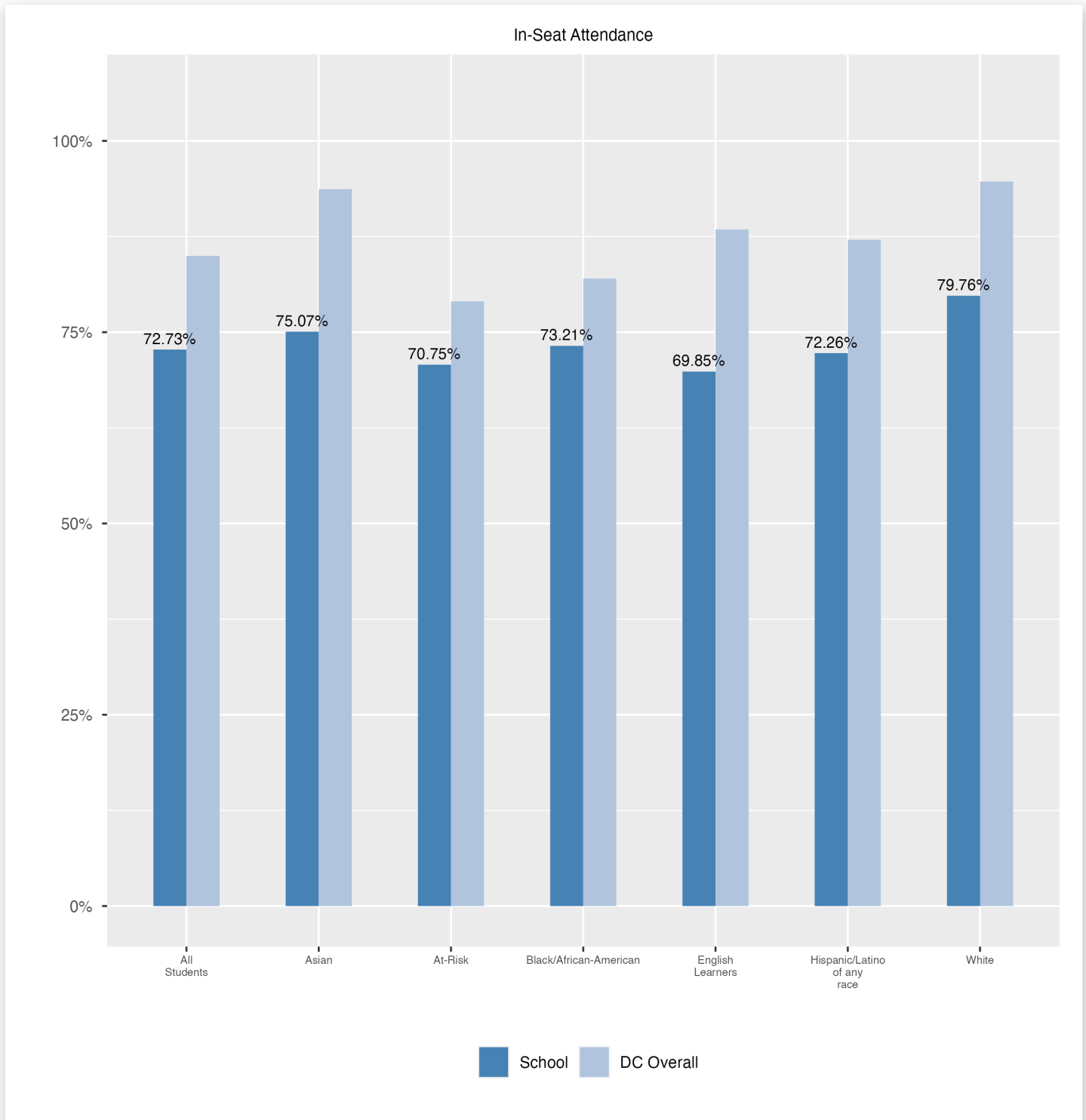


School Safety and Discipline

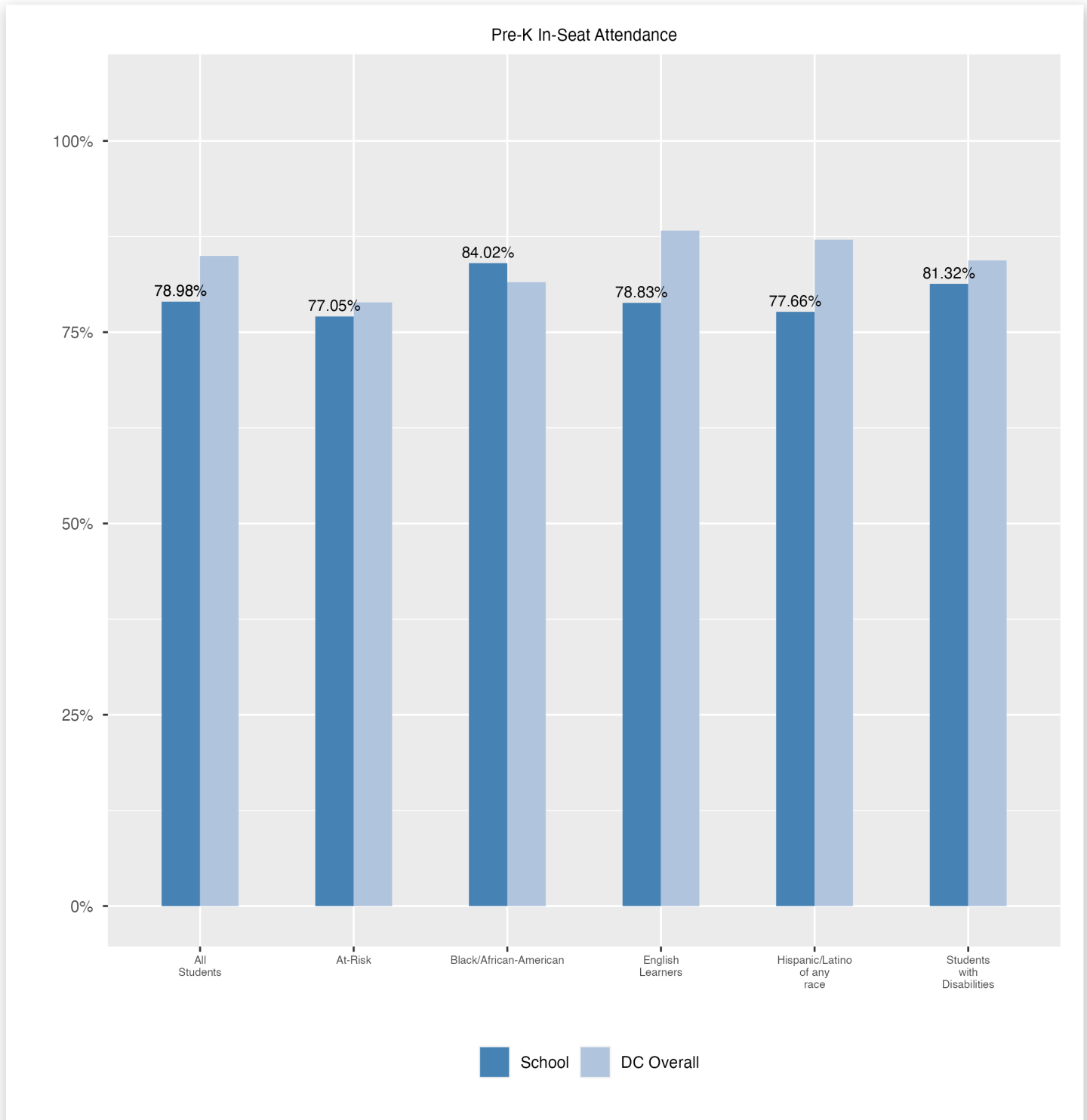
